



## C.H.A.T. Toolkit Training

Children Harmed by Alcohol Toolkit can be used with children aged 3 to 16 years, families or parents who have been affected by someone in their life's drinking.

C.H.A.T. can be used in a range of different settings including; social work, children's charities, treatment services or those working in community justice.

To support practitioners to use the resource, Alcohol Focus Scotland provides a one day training programme.

All organisations seeking to use C.H.A.T. **must** have at least one member of staff complete this training programme.



## Learning Outcomes

On completion of training learners will have:

- Increased awareness of the problems caused by alcohol in Scotland.
- Greater awareness of the impact of alcohol harm on individuals, children, young people and families.
- Identified ways to use the C.H.A.T. resource within their own working environment.
- Increased confidence and skills to use the C.H.A.T. resource.
- Greater awareness of the support available
